We are now all in Alert Level 4 which means that our school will not be open onsite for any students. This follows someone being identified with COVID-19 and who has been in the Auckland and Coromandel communities while believed to be infectious.

With such short notice we were unable to distribute devices or hard packs to students, at this point in time no one is allowed access to the school, so we cannot consider getting this process underway yet. Today teachers will be reaching out and communicating with you and / or your children with some information and ways to support learning from home in the coming few days.

- Teachers use Seesaw as one of the main forms of communication to the class, if you have not got access to this please email your teacher for instructions (teacher email list will be published on facebook and emailed out to our school email list).
- If you are not receiving email updates (or the weekly school newsletter via email) we do not have your email address in our system, please email office@taupoprimary.school.nz and ask to be added to our whole school communication list.
- We will continue to use facebook, email and seesaw as our main forms of communication. If you cannot access these easily, please contact your teacher so we can work out ways to get information to you.

You can usually expect daily updates with a range of activities, tasks and ideas that your child/ren can carry out to continue learning from home. There will be a selection of online / digital activities and a selection of non digital activities and ideas. We would love you to share parts of your home learning with the teachers, this could be done via seesaw or e-mailing the teacher.

Our focus is to support the learning at home, however the wellbeing of your family must come first. Please do not let the daily tasks or ideas create undue stress at home for yourself or your family. Do what you can, when you can, with the resources you have available.

Please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher, if there is something you need assistance with.
