Our kids Greening Taupo group have been offered to attend and celebrate ARBOR DAY! A community planting event where 2000 trees are being planted from 11.00-2.00 ish. Well done to all those families who are supporting this cause.

Our achievement challenge- we have been working hard this term on our writing challenge that we have at our school. We are currently reviewing and looking at what is working, not working, needs tweaking etc. I was very concerned to see that a number of our learners who are receiving support have **BAD ATTENDANCE**. Please support us to help your child and try to get them here regularly it does impact on your child's learning. Our programs run everyday and it's difficult for learners when they miss sessions to try and catch up. It's also unrealistic to expect teachers to get your child where they need to be.

Ministry tolerance around attendance- the acceptable tolerance for a child to be absent in one year is 10% or 1 week each term...20 days per year. This is a lot. However, we currently

have children with up to 40% absence. They are missing 4 weeks every term or 16 weeks each

year. Basically attending less than 2 and a half terms a year...this makes our job that much harder and your child's job extremely hard! The gap will widen for your child if they already struggle.

Music- HELP do you have a keyboard at home that you no longer use? We are in desperate need of another keyboard for our senior school music program. If you can help us we would love it!

Apologies-due to the short week our student panul this week has been missed. Next week Merryn and Emily will join us and give you the latest up-date of what is happening around our Kura!
