- Every year the board submit a 'Charter' to the Ministry of Education. A large part of the charter is our Annual Aims (focuses, areas for development, areas to monitor and action plans for these areas) these annual aims help to ensure Taupo Primary continues to be a highly effective place of learning. Your feedback may help in creating the annual aims for 2019.
