Double Parking on Tamamutu Street

If you pick up your children at the end of the school day, it is vital that you find appropriate parking before loading or unloading students. 'Double parking' near our pedestrian crossing is deemed by the council and police to be inconsiderate parking that you can be ticketed for. It causes congestion and impares the view of our crossing operators and staff.
