A huge and happy welcome back to everyone!

We have had a calm and relatively smooth transition back to school, despite the many restrictions and extra protocols we are having to implement and maintain.

Thank you so much for your patience and understanding at this time and thank you for taking the time to read our updates and signs around the school. Your understandings and preparation of the students has certainly added to the smooth transition back.

We have had almost all our staff and 86% of our students back onsite this week. It has been fantastic to see their smiling faces as they come in the gate each morning (despite the cold!).

The classes and atmosphere on the whole has been very calm and students are getting back into a routine. Many are seeming tired today, however that is to be expected, this is like week 1 of the year again, it takes times to build up school stamina. If you feel your child is just 'too tired' tomorrow, keep them home and aim for a full week next week. If this is the case, let the office know and we will mark this as a justified absence this week.

Tracking and Tracing - Parents can help by not coming into School.

While we want to operate as 'normal' as possible, during level 2 we are encouraged to limit the number of unnecessary people on school site. For this reason we are asking **parents / caregivers to avoid coming onsite if possible.**

ALL parents (apart from new entrant parents) will be required to be clear of the school site by 9.05am

Drop Off / Arriving At School

School starts for all students at the normal time of **8.55am**.

Students are welcome onsite from **8.15am** however classes will not be open until **8.30pm.** (Kelly Club will be operating for students that need care prior to 8.15). **Gate 1** (Main Office Gate - Tamamutu Street) will be the only gate open at **8.15am.**

Gate 3 (Ruapehu Street - Town Gate) will be open at 8.45

Gate 5 (Titiraupenga Street - Bus Gate) will be open to allow bus students through then open for other students at **8.45**.

If an **adult** is coming onsite (please try and avoid doing so) please **enter and exit by the same gate**.

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
