I am sure you were as pleased as I was to hear the Prime Minister's announcement about moving to Alert Level 1 early this week! We send out a parent update on Tuesday, this page contains much of that information and a few new things to know.

For us, there will be no major changes to what we are doing and how we are doing it. Our school continues to be safe to attend (including for any staff and children who are considered more vulnerable to COVID). Covid-19 is no longer a valid reason to be away from school. We have good cleaning routines in place, sanitiser will remain available, hand washing will still be encouraged. **Anyone** who is sick will still be required to stay at home, if symptoms present during the school day they will still be sent home.

We will not have clip board contact tracing for parents but we are supporting contact tracing by having QR code posters at our entrances – so if you haven't already downloaded the NZ COVID Tracer app the Ministry of Health's NZ-COVID Tracer app page has information to help you do that. Parents onsite during the school day are required under our normal health and safety procedures, to sign in at the office and get a visitors sticker.

We are looking forward to inter-school and community sport, cultural events and performances and to welcoming all of our school community on site for these activities.

Thank you all for your cooperation and understanding throughout this lengthy and challenging time. Together we got it done!



If you arrive for student pick up **before 2.55** and intend to wait until the bell, you need to sign in at the office. Please **wait OUTSIDE** the classroom, unless invited in by the teacher. MORNING DROP OFF TIMES REMAIN THE SAME

Our three current pedestrian gates (Main office gate - Gate 1, The town gate - Gate 3, Bus Gate - gate 5) will be **unlocked at 8.15** for students. Classes will be open at 8.30.

Sadly, we farewell Mrs Lightfoot from Room 14, who is taking on a new adventure. We are working through a recruitment process to find an amazing replacement for the class.
