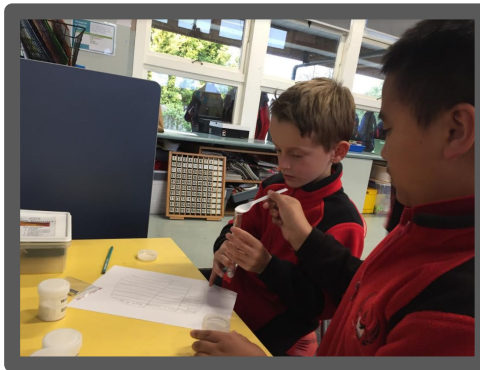

## 'Ko te ako te maneatanga' 'Hooked on Learning'

### Celebrating being HOOKED ON LEARNING in Rooms 12-15



**Room 15** has learnt about using harakeke for craft work. We made harakeke stars for Matariki. We have loved working cooperatively with our buddy class, Room 2, helping them with their learning. For a technology challenge we had to work with a partner and use only newspaper and sellotape to create a free standing tower.



Over the past two weeks, **Room 14** has been completing a science kit called Who Dunit? We have been learning forensic techniques that people use to solve crimes. First we tested our fingerprints and we had to find out which type of fingerprint we each had. Then we looked at different fibres and what the differences were. We also looked at handwriting samples, to find the differences between how people write based on their form of letters. Finally we completed a white powder test with salt, flour, washing soda and citric acid to see the pH levels. Using these four forensic techniques we were then able to solve a crime. We enjoyed this science kit because it had lots of fun activities and we learnt that everyone is unique.


