#### Ki ora i te whanau,

As we near the end of Maori Language week, I would like to thank the staff, students, whanau and community that have shared or taken part in celebrating and helping us improve our ability in Te Reo Maori.

As we hopefully near the end of Covid-19 alert level 2, I once again want to thank everyone for your ongoing patience and understanding as we have tried to continue normal operations with restrictions. Moving into level 1, there will not be many changes. A couple of the main changes: We will likely get back to whole school gatherings, such as our powhiri to welcome new students and whanau to our school. We will have our Road Crossing Patrol back in

action.


