

While the Year 5's were at camp, the Year 4's from Room 17 studied Dr Seuss' 'The Lorax' and became creative.






Thanks to the best group of parents ever

Taupo Town Centre Transformation Project

The next phase of the Taupo Town Centre Transformation project will soon get underway, with the **upgrade of Horomatangi and Ruapehu streets intersection.**

The major works will take place between Monday November 30 and Wednesday December 23 and include upgrading the intersection to a roundabout, adding raised pedestrian crossings and improving access into, and out of, Horomatangi Street.

Parents and caregivers please take care around these intersections and the school while this project is being undertaken. Overnight road closures and traffic management will take take place during this time.
