Pedestrian Crossing On Tamamutu Street


This is a full pedestrian crossing with normal crossing rules applying.

In the past at 3pm this has been operated as a kia crossing (manned by students and a teacher). Due to the confusion of motorists about 'not needing to stop if the kia crossing patrol are not there' and the number of near misses this has caused at other times of the day, the police have been looking into the matter.

As a result, we have been directed to stop manning and operating the crossing as a kia crossing. We are now to teach the students how to cross a normal crossing safely. Plans for community education around crossings are also being looked at.

We will continue to have an adult out in the afternoons helping students to cross safely.
