

School Field Renewal is a Go!

Wow! Since the last update our Project Manager (WSP) have submitted everything we need to the Ministry for final approval, and the Ministry have turned things around at unheard of speed and given approval to proceed! As soon as Camex heard this, they have responded at haste to ensure our grass gets sown in time for growing weather! They want to start setting up a work site next week. This is fantastic news! As we mentioned earlier this term we will have to work hard to accommodate the project as the field will be out of action for a good few months. We are finalising plans with the teachers today so we are set for next week, when Camex's boundary fences go up.

What does this project look like?

We will be getting a brand new field that is irrigated for all year round green! The interface and path between the field and rooms 16-21 will be addressed to create eating spaces, new trees and get rid of the dust trail.

The project involves the removal of A LOT of existing soil to ensure we have top quality soil for longevity of the grass. The tonnes of soil that would be normally dumped will be utilised to create a bund / banking along Titiraupenga Street, this is a joint project between the School and the Council to try and mitigate some of the noise and traffic disruption that the recently announced by-pass road will create on Titiraupenga Street. To establish this bund and some dense planting along the fence line for a sound barrier, we will see the removal of the large conifer type trees to make way for new planting and the bund. We are excited that the bund will be fully planted out on the roadside by the contractors and the top and school side will become a new planting and design space for our school and community to develop over time, with funds already secured for tree and plant purchasing.

We have been VERY fortunate to have the Ministry Of Education allow us to carry out the field renewal as part of a Ministry funded project. It will be happening during term time, and we will all be working together to mitigate any disruption to learning and playspaces. Thank you for your ongoing support and understanding as we work to better the learning environment for all our students.
