Seasons groups are for children who have change or loss in their life. This could be due to changes at home such as a loved one dying or parents separating, moving away or going to prison. The groups are small and are facilitated by trained adult companions. Children of a similar age sing, talk and play together in confidence as they grow to understand their feelings and their personal situation of grief or loss. Groups run each school term, either as an after school programme or at various Schools during normal study hours. Most children who come say they like Seasons a lot!

We are offering after-school programmes on Tuesdays from 3.30 to 4.30 pm for nine weeks excluding any school holidays. The programme is held at St Andrews Anglican church. 
