Thank you to our School Board of Trustees who have all declared their status as vaccinated and are providing their evidence to start our database!


Taupo Primary School Covid 19 - Level 2 REMINDERS

Please do not come on site if you do not NEED to.


- Ideally drop off and pick up children at gates
