## Keep Us In The Loop - Let Us Know

Please let the office know (email is preferred, office@taupoprimary.school.nz):

- If any of your enrolled children test positive.
- If any enrolled children are having to isolate at home due to a family close contact.
- If any child enrolled that is already in isolation develops Covid-19 during isolation.
- If you are keeping your children home as a precaution.

### **Class & Staffing Disruptions**

We are already experiencing high levels of student absence. We anticipate at some point we will also experience higher than usual staff absences (and for long periods ie 10 days at a time). We will do everything we can to source relievers, however the demand on Taupo's Relief teacher pool is very high. Getting relievers is already presenting a challenge. There are a number of things that may happen in the case of low class numbers and unavailability of staff.

- Ideally we will engage the same reliever for the whole time the teacher is not available.
- Classes may have a couple of different relievers while their teacher is away.
- Classes may be split some days and go to another teacher within the same team (when relievers are not available).
- Classes may be split for the entire length of the class teacher absence.

These decisions will be made case by case basis, sometimes morning by morning! We will do our best to keep you well informed of the changes to your child's class, teacher and location.


