Kia Ora Whanau,

This week I want to again take the time to thank you for your support and understanding as we navigate Covid-19 in a completely new way. I can assure you that we, as a school, are and will continue to do everything we can to

remain open to all students (who are well or not in isolation) for as long as we can.

For the last couple of weeks we have had around  $\frac{1}{3}$  of all our students and one or two teachers at home at any given time.

Until this week we have been able to cover <u>most</u> staff absences with a consistent teacher or reliever. Towards the end of this week we have seen an increase in the number of staff needing to be at home and a slight reduction in the number of students at home. This has resulted in the need to split some classes for a day or two. If our school follows this trend of increasing staff absences in the coming week or two,

there will be a further need to split classes.

This has not, and should not, result in over crowded classes as we still a have high level of student absences.

If we have a need to split your child's class for more than a day or two, we will endeavour to let you know via seesaw (or a note home) as to who's class your child will be in until their main teacher returns or we secure a reliever.

Thank you again for your understanding and patience. Your support and certainly makes it easier to for all our teachers and staff.


