## <u>Lights / Pedestrian</u> <u>Crossings</u>

# Taupo Primary School School Board Elections

Nominations are open for the election of 3 parent representatives to the school board.

Use this form to nominate yourself or someone in your community. You will also have received a nomination cover letter calling for nominations. Information on who is not eligible to be a board member is provided with the nomination form.

Nominations close at **noon** on **Wednesday 3rd August**. You may provide a signed candidate statement and photograph with your nomination.

The electoral roll is held at the school and can be viewed during normal school hours.

As nominations are received, there will be a list of candidates' names kept at the school up until election day, which you can view.

Voting closes at 4pm on Wednesday 7th September.
