The senior school have been so thankful for having three amazing sessions with Michael last week. We were able to refine our bowling and batting skills in amongst a lot of laughs and fun.

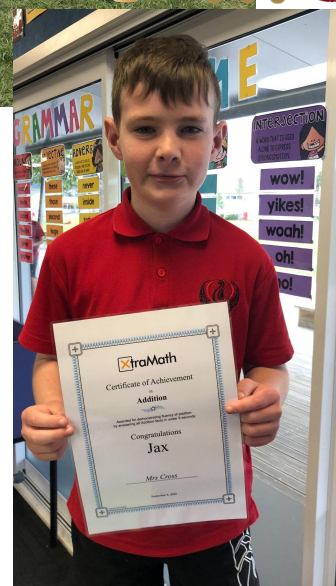


## PERSUASIVE WRITING

Our Year 5 and Year 6 students who competed in an across school maths competition.



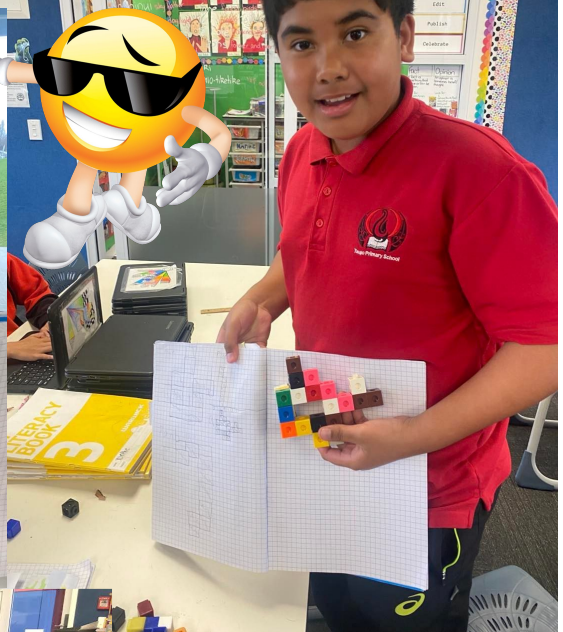
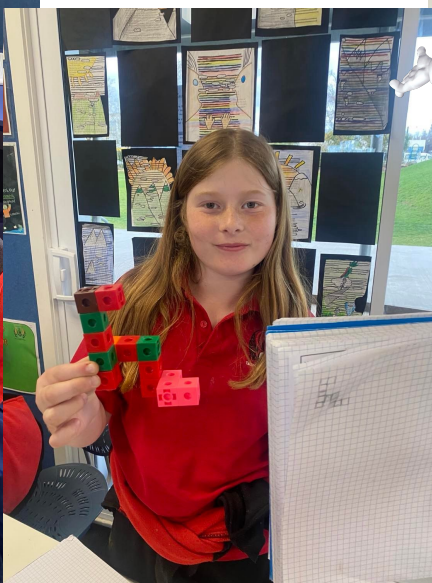
In Room 20 we are awarded for demonstrating fluency of basic facts by answering all basic facts in under 6 seconds. Here is **Jax** with his addition award.
