Teeth Tips 3

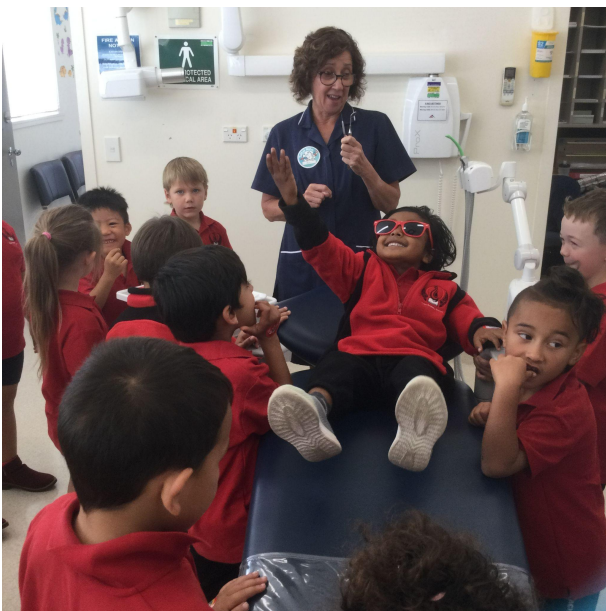
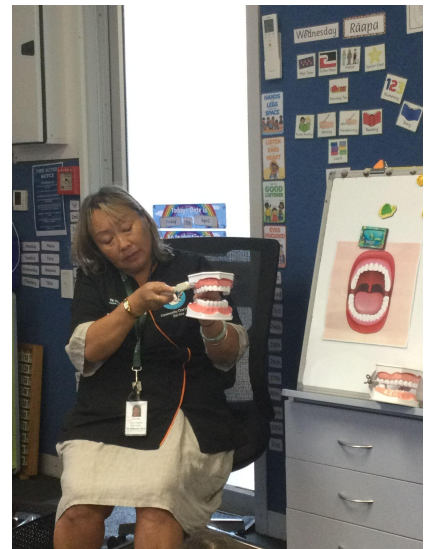
Tooth decay is the second most common disease among humans. But it is preventable by brushing, flossing and going for regular checks.

Teeth should be brushed twice a day-after breakfast and before bedtime.

When brushing teeth, brush in small circles including near the gum line.

Make sure you brush all surfaces of the teeth and brush the front and back of the teeth.

Remember to brush your tongue!
